Andres G. Muniz Jr. 79, of Harlingen entered into rest Saturday, July 27, 2013. He was born December 4, 1933 in Harlingen, Texas to Andres Muniz Sr. and Clemencia Muniz. He is preceded in death by his parents and 3 brothers, Dr. Leofredo Muniz, Leonel Muniz and Edward Muniz. He is survived by his loving wife, Dahlia; his daughter Gloria Morales (Frank) San Antonio TX.; his son Andy Muniz III, Denver CO., numerous grandchildren and great grandchildren; 3 brothers, Ret.
