Angelina Treviño, aged 82, died peacefully on December 29, 2017 in Austin, Texas. Angie was born June 18, 1935, in Mercedes, Texas, and was one of nine children born to Manuel Treviño and Hortencia Garcia who immigrated to the United States from Mexico in 1926.

Angie grew up surrounded by strong-willed, opinionated, and fiercely independent brothers and sisters. Quiet in comparison but a quick-witted negotiator, Angie was the loving pacifist that often acted to ensure tranquility and peace in the family. She was intelligent, hardworking and industrious, and committed to God and the Catholic faith.

Angie was a devoted single Mom and extremely proud of her daughter Laura. She worked long and hard to ensure that Laura had every opportunity in life. Angie enjoyed a successful career with Dickie’s Clothing, starting as a seamstress and rising to a position of overseeing operations at their facility in Weslaco, Texas before retiring at the age of 72.

Angie lived her entire life with her parents and along with her sister Elida, were the primary care-givers for “Papa Mel” and “Mama Tencha” until their passing.

Angie thoroughly enjoyed living life. She regularly watched her favorite novelas and the Seinfeld comedy show and was an avid, die-hard fan of the Dallas Cowboys. Angie acted as a stabilizing influence for many of her nieces

and nephews and was always available to offer her wisdom and sage advice. Angie was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Mercedes and an active volunteer in numerous faith-based organizations.

Angie is preceded in death by her parents, Manuel and Hortencia, her brother Manuel Jr., her sisters Eva, Elma, Emma, and Juanita. Angie is survived by her sisters Jeannie and Elida, her brother Mario, her daughter Laura and son-in-law Nick, as well as 28 nieces and nephews and their families.
