Our beloved Mother Antonia Robles was 90 years old when God remembered her and called her home.

She was born on April 24, 1933, in Brownsville, Texas the daughter of Simon and Antolina Nino. She had seven siblings Vicente, Guadalupe, Francisca, Luciano, Simon, Martin and Senorina.

She met and married the love of her life Jesus Robles on January 16, 1954. She always said with a smile on her face, that she had married a handsome man with beautiful green eyes. Dad was a widower with five children, Guadalupe, Maria de la Luz, Josefina, Idolina and Jesus Jr II. They were married for 55 years and had seven more children Jose, Elvia, Ramon, Evangelina, Eglantina, Jesse Jr III and Minerva. She and dad were blessed to have 36 grandchildren and many great grandchildren and great, great grandchildren.

Mom migrated with dad and most of the family for work from Texas to Washington stopping in different states along the way to stay with relatives and to work in the fields harvesting the crops. She picked grapes, cherries, peaches, apricots, prunes to name a few and cut asparagus alongside dad and the family for years. She would get up early to make fresh tortillas and delicious tacos so we could eat lunch in the field. When we lived in Arizona

our house was located on the outskirts of town, when dad was not there she had to be extra brave to protect us from all the rattlesnakes and scorpions that also lived there. They did not stand a chance against our fierce mother and many of them lost their heads if they got close to her children. She and dad were devoted Catholics and taught us about faith, prayer and the importance of love and family. No matter where we traveled, we always went to church and learned about Jesus along the way. She and dad eventually settled in Washington and dad became a trucker so she stopped working the fields. In their older years they moved back to Harlingen to be close to their Texas family.

Mom had rheumatoid arthritis since she was very young but no matter how much pain she was in, that never stopped her from taking care of dad and all of us to the best of her ability. She was amazing and not afraid of hard work and made sure her family had what they needed to be successful. There was always hot food ready for us when we got home from school and she was forever washing clothes and cleaning the house. She had a great sense of humor and was good at making dad and everyone laugh. She loved to sing while she cooked and her food was always sabrosa even if it was just beans and a hot tortilla. She was a loving wife, mother, grandmother, sister, aunt and friend and shared her love with all our amazing family.

She was preceded in death by her husband Jesus Robles parents Simon and Antolina Nino, Sister Guadalupe and Brothers Vicente, Martin and Luciano may they all rest in peace.
