



## Cabot G. Goslin

September 26, 1979 - May 5, 2015

Cabot G. Goslin, 35, died on Tuesday, May 5, 2015, from injuries sustained in a one vehicle accident in San Juan, Texas.

Cabot was born September 26, 1979 in San Benito, Texas. He grew up in El Paso, Texas and graduated from Onate High School in Las Cruces, New Mexico. After graduating, Cabot went on to serve his country in the United States Marine Corps. After several tours in the Marines, Cabot was honorably discharged. He continued to serve his country as a security contractor serving in Iraq. Cabot returned home, to Harlingen, Texas. It was here that Cabot met his beautiful wife, Danielle and they both settled here with their son, Magnus. After a series of successful but unsatisfying jobs, Cabot, with the ever-loving support and encouragement from his wife, found his niche. Cabot became a New York Life consultant in Harlingen and quickly rose the ladder to success as a New York Life partner.

Cabot made friends everywhere he went and worked. He had a magnetic personality that made people want to be in his company. He will be missed.
