Dorothy A. Miller, 81, of Harlingen passed away Thursday, January 26, 2023 surrounded by her loving family. She was born December 20, 1941 in Harlingen, TX to Chester Booth and Alby Simecek Booth.

Dorothy is preceded in death by her parents and her husband, Herbert Miller. She is survived by her daughter, Mary Aycock and husband, David; and her son, John Miller.

Dorothy was a loving mother to Mary and John and a devoted wife of 38 years to Herbert before his passing in 2006. Dorothy was an only child to older parents who cherished her. She attended St. Anthony Catholic School as a child. After growing up in Harlingen, she went to college to become a secretary, one of few professions available in that era. She moved to San Antonio and worked in the city government offices, eventually married and had two children. The family moved back to Harlingen in 1978. For over a decade Dorothy was the sole caregiver of her mother, who suffered from dementia. She sacrificed many years of her life in unpaid labor. She took care of her husband, who developed cancer multiple times. After her mother died, she helped Herbert in his appliance repair business, going on calls with him. She was a lifelong Catholic and attended St. Anthony Catholic Church. Despite all challenges, she kept a smile on her face for those around her. She is dearly missed.

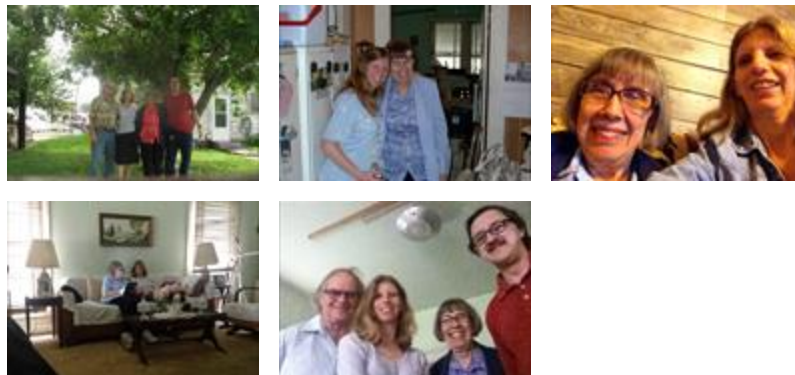
