She enjoyed the holiday events participating joyfully in costume dress ups and family games. She enjoyed gardening and sitting outside admiring her garden bloom and watching the birds and hummingbirds.

Panchita was such a devoted mother and grandmother finding time and energy to also care for her growing grandchildren.

She enjoyed traveling, visiting many sites in Texas, Colorado, Utah, and Nevada. Wherever she traveled, Panchita was sure to express her joyful and pleasant persona attracting smiles and greetings from friends and strangers. Her smile, a contagious one, and her extended hand gestures always brought the human touch to her heart.

Dementia took Panchita's ability to recognize family and friends; but the disease did not affect her heartwarming love and compassion. If given the opportunity, she would keep a firm grip of the hand during a handshake. She always sent family and friends with God's blessings.
