Pallbearers will be brothers Jose Rincon, Rodolfo Rincon, Genaro Rincon Jr.

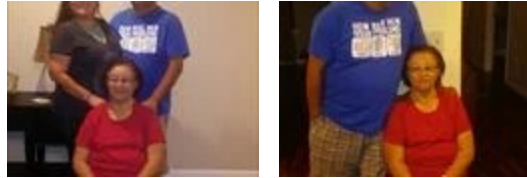
Emilio Rincon, brother in law Tom Casares, and nephew Genaro Diego Rincon.
