Serving initially as a first-grade teacher then changing her focus to working with migrant four and five-year olds. Her passion and commitment to teaching impacted and helped shape the lives of hundreds of children over the years. Also, a faithful Catholic, she served many years as a CCD teacher for the Sacred Heart parish in Mercedes. Lidia was a deeply spiritual and humble woman; she touched the lives of many young and old through her acts of charity and kindness, giving generously to those in need.

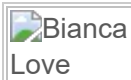
