



## Jesus "Chuey" Ramos

January 12, 1944 - March 3, 2025

Jesus 'Chuey' Ramos, 81, was called by our Lord and Savior with his family by his side on March 3, 2025. Chuey was born in Harlingen, Texas, to Eduardo and Elodia Ramos on January 12, 1944.

A life long resident of Harlingen, Chuey worked as a manager for Firestone in Brownsville and San Benito and became a real estate agent for Van Wyk Reality, all while developing his own properties.
