



Leo Herrera

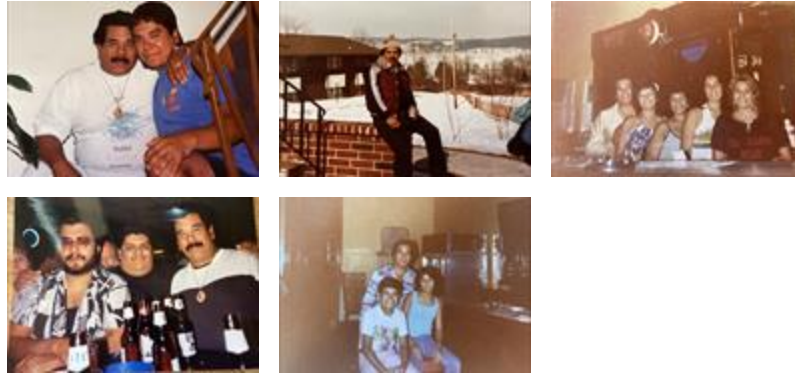
August 17, 1940 - April 23, 2023

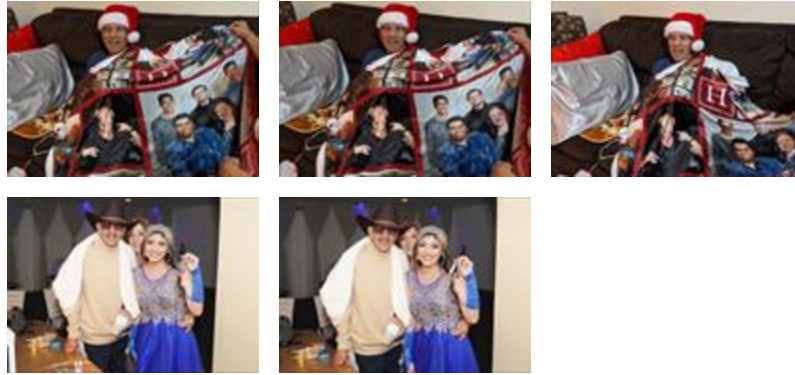
