



Maricela Alvarado

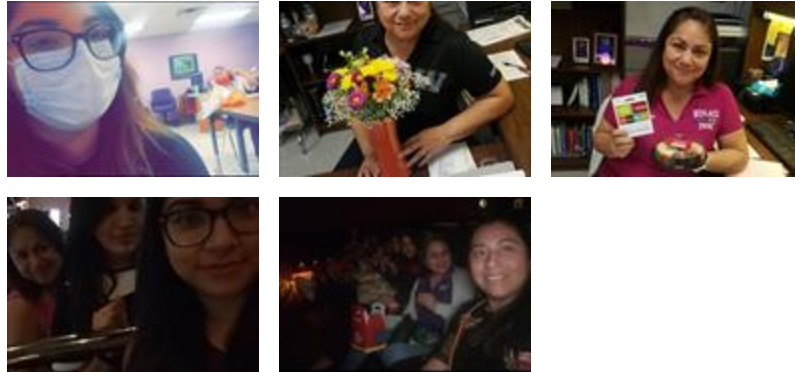
