Pedro G. Garcia 95, of Harlingen entered into rest May 5, 2021. He was born in Hebronville, TX April 17, 1926 to Sabas Garcia and Maria del Refugio. He is preceded in death by his parents; his wife, Juanita D. Garcia; brothers, Israel Garcia and Jose Guadalupe Garcia; sisters, Maria Sabitas Davila, Beatrice Cantu and Lydia Lozano.

He married Juanita D. Garcia, June 17, 1956 and they made their home in Harlingen. They were married for 53 years until her passing.

He was very proud of his display, many requests were asked to present his display throughout the Valley.

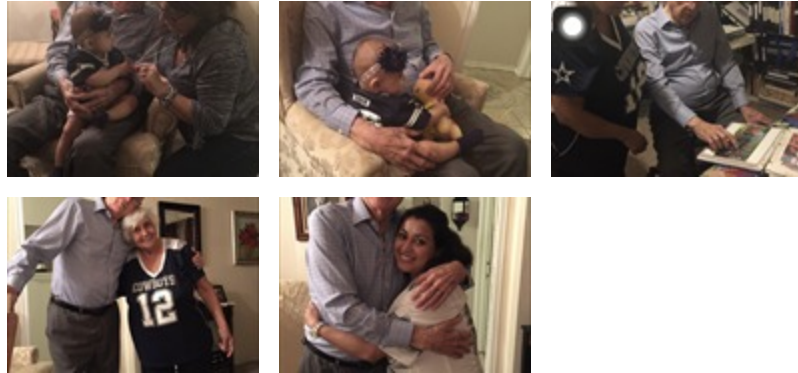

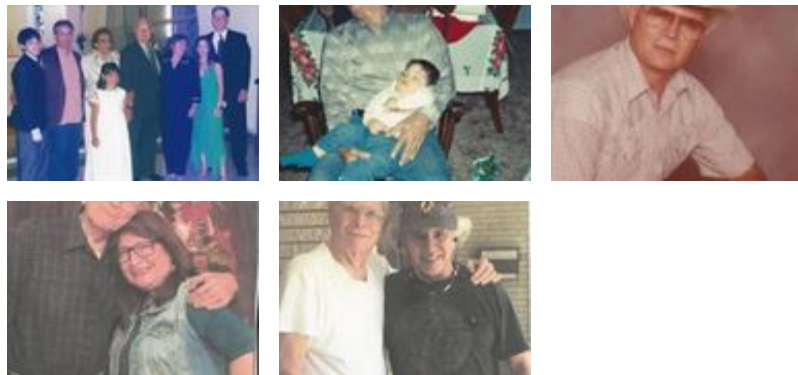
