Pedro Hinojosa, 72, of Santa Rosa, Texas, passed away on April 28, 2026, at Valley Baptist Medical Center in Harlingen, surrounded by his loving family while listening to his favorite music.

Motivated by the youth, Pedro studied and earned a teaching degree at Pan American University in Edinburg, in 1989, in La Feria, instantly connecting with both students and peers with both his infectious personality and fun-loving, lighthearted demeanor.
