February 7, 1929 - November 4, 2016

On November 4, 2016, Rebecca Peynado, peacefully passed away at age 87, surrounded by her children.

She was preceded in death by her loving husband, of 70 years, Ascension Peynado, her son, Reymundo Peynado, and daughter, Bobbi. Rebecca met her husband, Ascension Peynado, in Mercedes. Following his service in World War II, Ascension immediately sought out the girl that had he loved throughout his teenage years, and married her. Together, they raised a beautiful family.

Known affectionately as “Mom”, Rebecca focused her whole life on her family. Throughout her lifetime, she served many times over as homeroom mother, and Mercedes Tiger Band Booster. As a member of Immanuel Lutheran

Church, Rebecca was key in fundraising efforts to open the Mision Emanuel, by organizing a rummage sale, at the Mission, that ran every weekend for a span of over 2 years. Rebecca always emphasized the importance of education. She was so proud to know that all her children had earned a Bachelor's degree.
