HARLINGEN, TX. – Rogelio “Roy” C. Elizondo, of Harlingen, TX entered into eternal rest on February 2, 2022. He was born in Mercedes, TX to the late Pablo and Guadalupe Elizondo. Preceded in death by his wife of 61 years, Alicia G. Elizondo. Roy graduated from Mercedes High School in 1947. He attended Pan American College after having served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War. Roy spent his career in sales and eventually retired from Sears Roebuck and Company.

He was an active member of St. Anthony Catholic Church for over 50 years where he served as a Eucharistic Minister and was a lifetime member of the Knights of Columbus, eventually becoming a Fourth Degree Knight.
