It is with great sadness and a heavy heart that we announce the passing of our sweet, sweet mom. Teodora "Lola" Prado, a beautiful soul of 88 years, went to meet our Lord on the early morning of December 31, 2025.

She was fondly known as Lola or Lolita to those who knew her. She was born on February 16, 1937, in La Feria, Texas, a daughter of the late Antonio and Maria Velez Cobarrubias. She was a caring mother and wife, loved by her four children and husband of almost 60 years.
